A Charter Ordinance Relating to the Combining of the Office of Clerk With the Position of Human Resource Director and the Combining of the Office of Treasurer With the Position of Finance Director and Providing for the Appointment of the Clerk-Human Resource Director and Treasurer-Finance Director**

Charter Ordinance No. 100

A CHARTER ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COMBINING OF THE OFFICE OF CLERK WITH THE POSITION OF HUMAN RESOURCE DIRECTOR AND THE COMBINING OF THE OFFICE OF TREASURER WITH THE POSITION OF FINANCE DIRECTOR AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CLERK-HUMAN RESOURCE DIRECTOR AND TREASURER-FINANCE DIRECTOR.

The Village Board of the Village of Weston do ordain as follows.

Section 1. The Village of Weston, pursuant to secs. 61.195 and 66.01, [Wis.] Stats., hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of secs. 61.19, 61.25 and 61.26, [Wis.] Stats., which are in conflict with this ordinance.

Section 2. The office of the Village Clerk and the position of the Village Human Resource Director are hereby consolidated and the duties of both of these positions shall be performed by the person appointed as Village CLERK-HUMAN RESOURCE DIRECTOR by the Village President subject to confirmation by the Village Board, commencing May 1, 2001. The incumbent Village Clerk and the present Human Resource Director shall continue to serve in their separate offices until the appointment and qualification of the Village Clerk-Human Resource Director. If a vacancy occurs in either position prior to the Clerk-Human Resource's appointment, the Village Board may appoint the remaining incumbent to perform the duties of both positions.

Section 3. The office of the Village Treasurer and the position of Village Finance Director are hereby consolidated and the duties of both positions shall be performed by the person appointed as the Village TREASURER-FINANCE DIRECTOR by the Village President subject to confirmation by the Village Board, commencing on May 1, 2001. The incumbent Village Treasurer and the person presently occupying the position of Village Finance Director shall continue to serve in their separate position until the appointment and qualification of a Village Treasurer-Finance Director. If a vacancy occurs in either office prior to the Treasurer-Finance Director's appointment, the Village Board may appoint the remaining incumbent to perform the duties of both offices.

Section 4. The appointed Village Clerk-Human Resources Director and the appointed Treasurer-Finance Director shall each hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided in sec. 17.13, [Wis.] Stats.

Section 5. The Village Clerk-Human Resource Director shall perform all duties required of the office of Clerk and the position of Human Resource Director as provided by law and such other duties as the Village Board directs to be executed by the Clerk-Human Resource Director from time to time.

Section 6. The Village Treasurer-Finance Director shall perform all duties required of the office of the Treasurer and the position of Finance Director as provided by law and such other duties as the village Board directs to be executed by the Treasurer-Finance Director from time to time.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect 60 days after its passage and publication unless within such 60-day period a referendum petition as provided by sec. 66.01(5), [Wis.] Stats., shall be filed, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until it shall have been submitted to a new referendum vote of the electors and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
