Sec. 22.100. County/municipal emergency legislation.

This chapter is derived from joint action emergency government legislation between the county and the village, providing for a civil defense organization and for protection and promotion of public safety, health and welfare in the county during civil defense emergencies resulting from enemy action and with emergencies resulting from natural or manmade disasters.

Joint Action Emergency Government Ordinance No. 67 of the county board of supervisors, providing for a county/municipal joint action civil defense plan of organization as adopted by the county board on May 24, 1977, is made a part of this chapter by reference and is ratified and accepted by the village as provided by section III of the joint action ordinance.
