

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS OF
WESTON WATER UTILITY**

The Weston Water Utility has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to increase water rates. The increase is necessary due to increase in plant investment and operating expenses since the last rate increase in 1988.

The total increase in water revenues requested is \$128,279, which will result in an estimated overall rate increase of 7% over the water utility's present revenues. If the request is granted, the water bill for an average residential customer with a $\frac{5}{8}$ -inch or $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch meter who uses 15,000 gallons of water per quarter will increase from \$49.70 to \$50.75, or 2%.

A telephonic public hearing on the application has been scheduled for Wednesday, January 14, 2009, at 1:00 p.m. in the Village Municipal Center Board Room, 5500 Schofield Avenue, Weston, Wisconsin. Scheduling questions regarding this hearing may be directed to the PSCW at (608) 266-3766.
