

## **PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING**

Marathon County in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is preparing plans for widening an approximate  $\pm$  1.5 mile portion of Camp Phillips Road/CTH X in the Village of Weston, Marathon County. The project begins at Bernard Avenue and extends to about 1,000 feet north of Northwestern Avenue. The project which is being designed by CWE Inc. includes the following improvements: The existing two lane rural roadway will be widened to a four lane divided urban facility, a multi-use path will be constructed along the southbound roadway, and the existing three-span bridge over the Eau Claire River will be replaced with a two-span structure.

Camp Phillips Road is an arterial highway carrying a high volume of north-south traffic on the east side of Wausau. In response to increasing traffic volumes and the transition from rural to suburban land uses, Marathon County conducted a corridor study in the mid-1990's that included a preliminary plan, public involvement, impact evaluation and preparation of an environmental document.

The county subsequently purchased the land needed for the proposed improvements and constructed the Lahr Avenue (frontage road) extension as an interim safety improvement. Roadway construction was originally targeted for 2002, but was delayed due to funding aspects. Funding has now been allocated, an updated environmental document is being prepared, and roadway and bridge construction are targeted for 2011.

The intent of this meeting is to present the final design and construction schedule and project timeline. Representatives from Marathon County, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and CWE, Inc. (design engineer) will be present to discuss the project.
