

**VILLAGE OF WESTON, MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
NOTICE OF NEWLY ENACTED ORDINANCE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village of Weston enacted a new Chapter 10 of the Village ordinances entitled “Animals” on the 4th day of August, 2008. Sections 10.100 through 10.141 deal with animal control and licensing, requiring animals to be cared for in such manner that they will not become a public nuisance, requiring animals to be properly fed, sheltered and cared for, requiring the removal of animal defecation from public property, requiring inspections and licensing of commercial pet establishments and pet kenneling facilities and to insure licensing and rabies vaccination of all dogs and cats within the Village. Sections 10.201 through 10.206 deal with dangerous dogs by defining and prohibiting dangerous dogs and setting up a procedure for declaring dogs dangerous along with the manner and procedure for destruction of dangerous dogs. Sections 10.300 through 10.301 deal with hunting and defines archery zones, non-restricted zones, and permitted activity zones, and makes provisions for special archery hunting permits. The new Chapter 10 also provides for penalties and enforcement.
