Council Event Registration Information

Program Guide

1. This program guide has been mailed to all registered girls and adults.
2. Additional program guides are available online at www.girlscoutsbirchtrails.org or may be requested from the Girl Scouts of Birch Trails Council office.
3. Girls are welcome to sign up individually or as a troop.
4. We hope to encourage family involvement in the Girl Scout experience. Please note the “Family Event” section, which lists events that are open for whole family participation. We respectfully request that non-registered siblings (brothers) do not participate in girl-only events.

Chaperones and Payment

1. All girls will need adult chaperones when attending events. Girl/adult ratios from Safety-Wise must be followed.
2. All costs are listed for registered and non-registered girls and adults. If there is no cost listed for an adult, then the chaperones do not pay a fee.
3. Girls who have sisters four years or older attending an event with them will be charged the non-registered girl fee and automatically registered. Brothers attending “family events” will be charged the non-registered girl fee. Boys cannot become registered with Girl Scouts of Birch Trails Council, but the extra fee must be charged due to the extra liability insurance required and necessary administrative costs.
4. Permission slips and health history forms are the responsibility of the chaperones.
5. A separate registration and payment are required for each program/event.

Choosing Events and Registration

1. All registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations MUST include full payment.
2. Non-members must pay the additional membership fee and complete a membership form, Bring-a-Friend form, or adult quick registration form. The form needs to be received at the council office at least one week in advance in order to attend the event.
3. Cookie and Nut/Magazine Credit may be used to cover all or part of a fee for any event. Cookie Credit will be available for use after December 1, 2006. Nut/Magazine Credit will be available for use after May 1, 2007. Both Cookie and Nut/Magazine Credit expire August 21, 2007.
4. Please advise your troop leader of any events that you are registering for as an individual.

Financial Assistance

1. Financial assistance is available to all registered members for all events. Forms are available at the Girl Scout Council Office and online at www.girlscoutsbirchtrails.org. Girls are encouraged to sell products to support their program participation.
2. All financial assistance requests MUST be submitted at least 30 days prior to the event.

Confirmation Letters

1. Confirmation letters with event details will be mailed after the registration deadline.
2. Confirmation letters will include directions, what to bring, and any special instructions.
3. If an email address has been provided, confirmation letters will be sent electronically.

Refunds

1. Full refunds will be made ONLY if the event is already full, if it is necessary to cancel a program, or in the case of a family or medical emergency.
2. Requests for refunds must be made in writing.
3. Refunds WILL NOT be made if a participant is sent home due to homesickness, misconduct, or parental request. If a participant is sent home, transportation is to be arranged and paid for by the participant’s parent or guardian.

GIRLS AGES 11-17 STUDIO 2B

STUDIO 2B – For all girls, ages 11 to 17, to become, belong, believe and build – is a program approach by The Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) for pre-teens and teens.

"We're not Brownies with longer legs," teens told GSUSA in the 2001 New Directions for Girls 11 to 17 research study, which prompted the creation of STUDIO 2B.

Concerned about their image and wanting to let go of anything that seems "too young" the teens surveyed said too often Girl Scouts is seen as a "kid thing."

Today's teens are looking for challenges and flexibility as the survey determines. While keeping with the core values of Girl Scouting, STUDIO 2B

takes the traditional earning of badges and awards and gives it a contemporary flare.

In STUDIO 2B, teens choose from a menu of new and exciting activities with flexible ways to participate.

It allows teens to earn stylish charms after completing focus books like "On the Go," where they find travel tips and related activities that help them learn the process of traveling from applying for a passport to learning how to order a dinner in Spanish.

STUDIO 2B also offers short-term interest groups like cheerleading, horseback riding, and karate, where teens may meet for the day or once a month for a few sessions.

Teens can also work on their individual accomplishments such as scholarships, Gold Award projects, and other awards only offered through GSUSA.

The opportunities are endless. All that's needed to complete the program are teens interested in exploration of their interests and mentors: women and men who are interested in guiding these teens in their decisions and dreams.

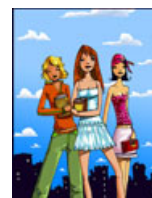
