Dear Mr. Schuster:

I am pleased to inform you that the state Department of Transportation has approved your requested Transportation Enhancements or Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Program project for state fiscal years 2011-2014 funding. The **Village of Weston - Birch Street Multi Use Path Extension** is one of forty-seven selected bicycle-pedestrian, historic transportation, and scenic landscaping related infrastructure projects that will enhance Wisconsin's transportation system and make it even more attractive to residents and visitors. Additionally, there are nine bicycle and pedestrian planning projects being funded.

A total of \$31.8 million in federal and state funding was approved for transportation-related infrastructure projects that were evaluated based on federal and state eligibility criteria, metropolitan planning organization priorities and recommendations made to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Secretary by a fourteen-person review committee. The state funding for the nine planning projects totals \$700,000.

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation will reimburse the public sponsor for up to \$546,400 of the total project cost. A representative from the Department of Transportation's region office in your area will contact you shortly and provide you with additional materials that need to be completed before you begin any work on your project. Do not incur costs until receiving notification that the project is authorized.
